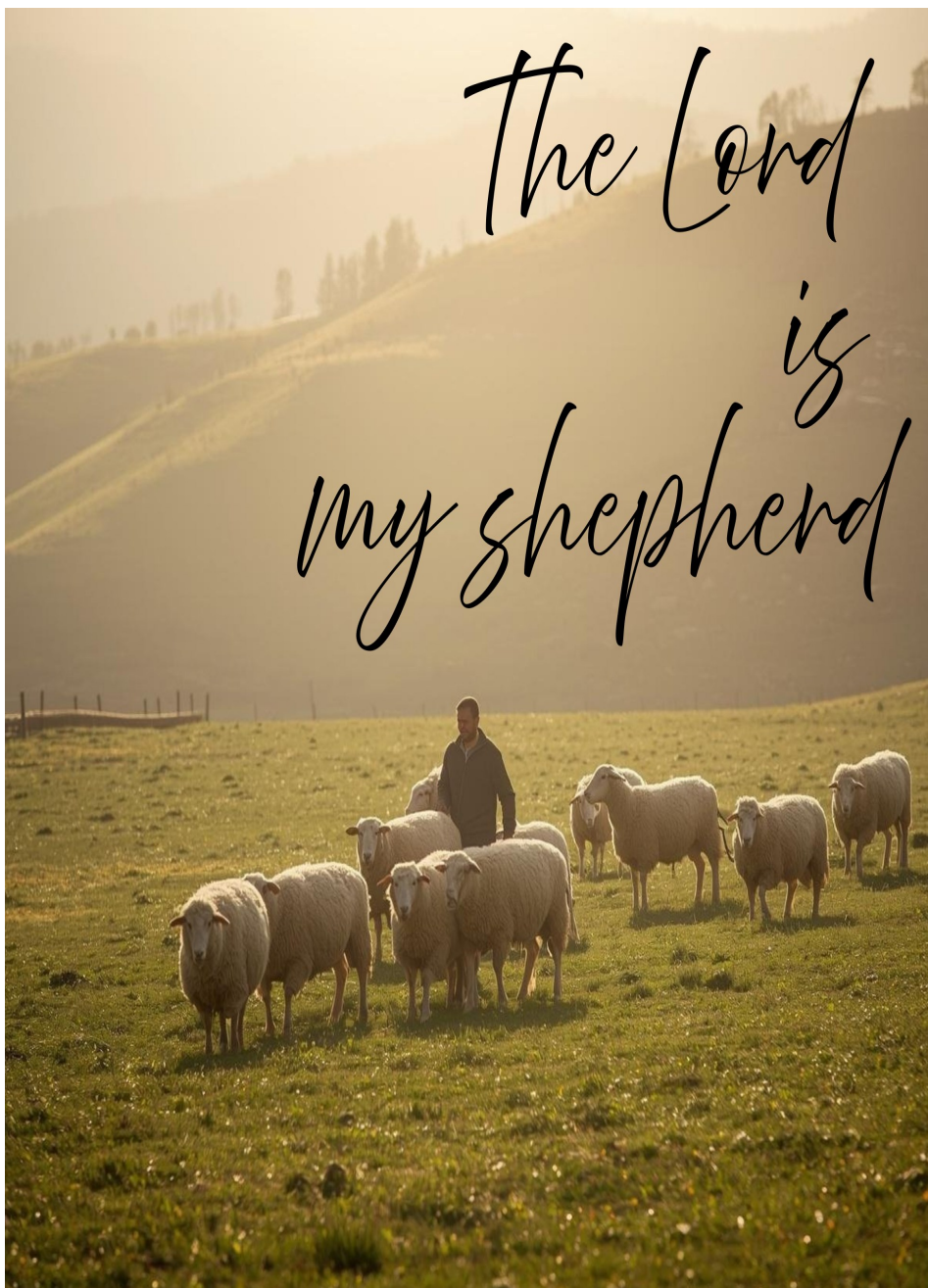

Our speakers are: **Ms Eileen Kelly** (Monday 11th May in Tubbercurry Church) who will speak on The Annunciation. **Fr John Carroll** will speak on The Visitation on Tuesday 12th in Cloonacool Church. On Wednesday evening, the 13th May, **Ms Louise McGuinness** will speak in Tubbercurry Church on the mystery of The Nativity. Thursday 14th May, we welcome **Mr Gerry Farrell** to Cloonacool where he will share some reflection on the mystery of The Presentation in The Temple and finally, on Friday evening, May 15th, **Bishop Donal Roche**, Auxiliary Bishop of Dublin, will bring our days of reflection to a close with some thoughts shared on Finding The Child Jesus in The Temple. The evening will include a word of welcome, setting the scene, a reading of the Gospel, followed by guest speaker's input, some short quiet time for reflection, and will conclude with "praying" the decade of the Rosary being highlighted.
