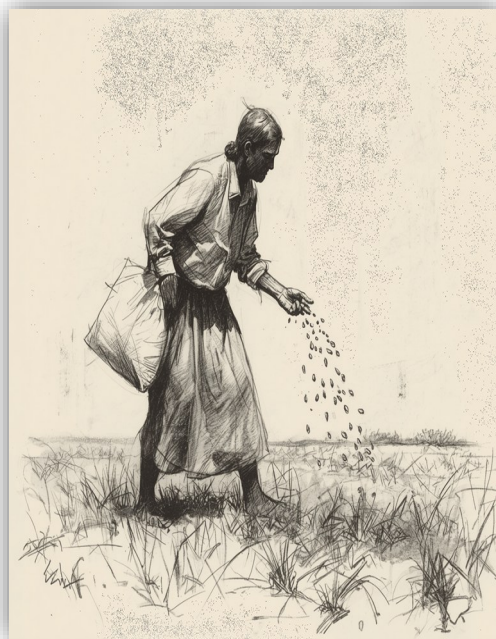


Tubbercurry | Cloonacool parish bulletin

As the seed falls to the earth, no distinction is made.

The sower scatters it in the hope and belief that a fruitful crop will emerge. Yet, the gospel tells us some of it will be quickly eaten by birds, more will spring up quickly but, without

root or purpose, only to die. Still more, will fall on the edges where growth is not possible. And, thankfully, some will fall into deep soil, put down life-giving roots and produce a crop deserving to be harvested.

In this weekend's Gospel passage, not alone does Jesus give us the text but he preaches the homily. He reminds us we are the seed, planted with love by the Sower in the hope, the knowledge that we can blossom. However, like the seeds, we will land in different places, have different outcomes but we are planted in love in the hope that we will find a place and peace in that depth of soil, where growth is possible and lives are lived.

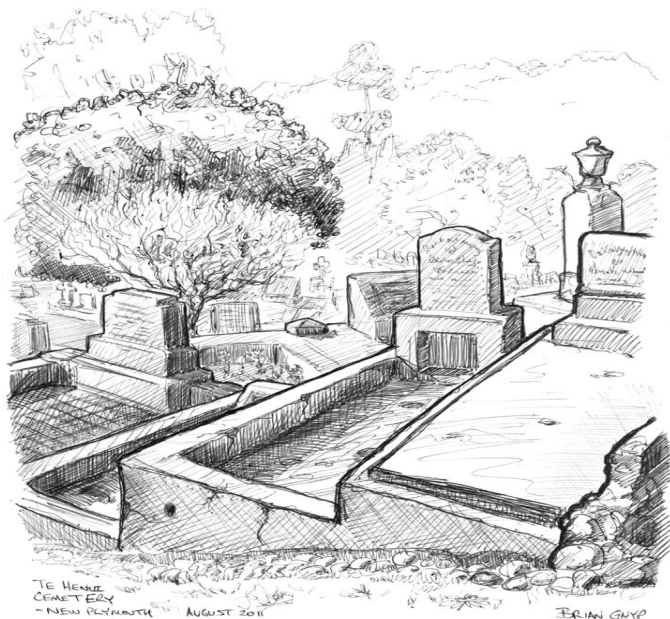
PIONEER PILGRIMAGE TO KNOCK
