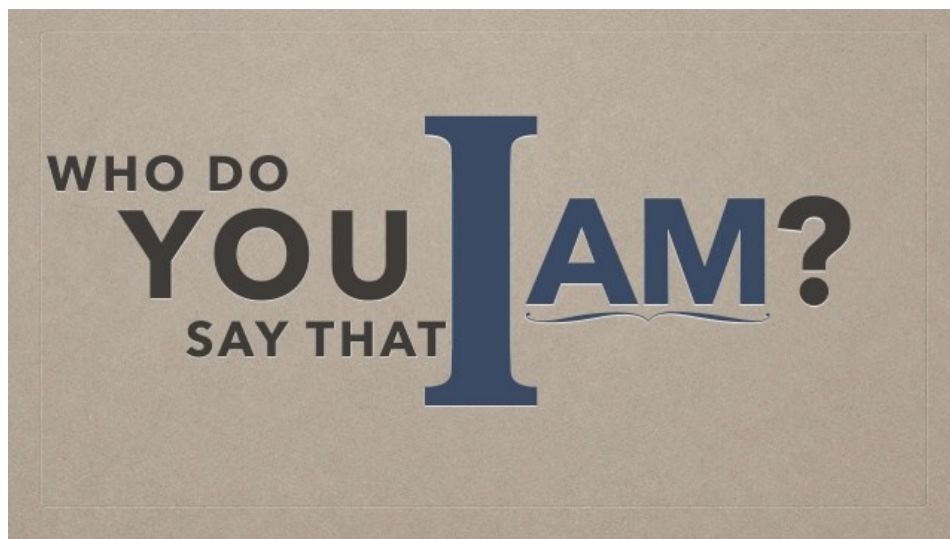


Tubbercurry Cloonacool
